Statement of Conformity

This document certifies that West Linn Paper Company products, including all basis weights and finishes of Sonoma, Capistrano, Nature and Nature Plus grades, comply with the toxicity limits imposed by the following standards and regulations:

- Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (Sections 101 and 108)
- CA Toxics in Packaging Act (Health & Safety Code Section 25214.11 to 25214.26)
- Coalition of Northeastern Governors (CONEG): Toxics in Packaging Clearinghouse's Model Legislation
- ASTM Toy Safety F 963 – 08 (Section 4.3)
- European Union's RoHS (Directive 2002/95/EC)
- European Union's REACH Program: Regulation EC No 1907/2006)

In addition:

- These products do not typically require labeling under CA Proposition 65, provided that they are used in a manner generally expected for coated papers.
- Ozone depleting substances were not used in the manufacture of these products, nor do they contain ODS, as defined in the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments (Sec. 602).
- All chemical substances used in the manufacture of this product are listed in the Toxic Substance Control Act inventory, and none are subject to action under Section 5, 6 and 7.

This certification is based on an ongoing review of raw materials used in the production process and periodic analytical analyses performed on a variety of grades and basis weights. The most recent analyses were conducted on paper produced between January and September 2011, with results received from the laboratory on January 11, 2012.
